



COASTAL GEORGIA TOUR JEKYLL ISLAND, ST SIMONS ISLAND, BRUNSWICK

Jekyll Island's newest hotel is ocean side and engulfed in a canopy of moss draped live oaks. Enjoy a short stroll via a boardwalk over a natural dunes system to the ocean. Their On the House™ hot breakfast buffet is complimentary each morning. Each room has both a microwave and refrigerator.

Tour Itinerary:

Day One - April 11, 2011:

Depart 7AM from K-Mart parking lot. Today we travel to southern Georgia. Rest and lunch stop en route arriving at our hotel approximately 4PM. A Welcome Reception awaits us upon arrival. Lodging for the next three nights is at the new ocean side Hampton Inn & Suites. Take a walk on the beach, then join us poolside for an included Low Country Boil Welcome Dinner. (D)

Day Two - April 12, 2011:

Enjoy our included breakfast at the hotel. First stop today is the Tidelands Nature Center for a short nature walk and hands on marine environmental visit. Next we leave Jekyll Island to visit St Simons Island. Stroll the quaint St Simons Island Village with time for lunch on your own. This afternoon we meet our guide, Jenny, for a St Simons Island tour, learning the history of the island and visiting Christ Church and Cemetery, Fort Frederica National Monument, and the Arthur J Moore Museum. Dinner tonight is in Brunswick, GA at the Cargo Portside Grill. (B, D)

Day Three - April 13, 2011:

Enjoy your included breakfast at the hotel. We spend today enjoying Jekyll Island. First stop is the Georgia Sea Turtle Center, a marine turtle rehabilitation, research and education facility opened in 2007. Lunch today is at the turn of the century Jekyll Island Club. After lunch, our trolley will pick us up for a tour of the historic district with a stop at a "cottage" or two of some of America's richest families. Take time to explore more of the historic district sites and shops after the tour. We return to our hotel for a walk on the beach and dinner on your own at our hotel's pub style lounge. (B, L)

Day Four - April 14, 2011:

Breakfast is included at our hotel. Before leaving the Coastal Georgia area we will stop near Darien, GA to visit the Hofwyl Broadfield Plantation (early 1800's rice plantation) for a film and guided house tour. One more stop up the road to see "the smallest church in America". Meal and rest stops en route, arriving in Burlington approximately 8PM. (B)
