### Tour Itinerary:

#### Day One - April 15, 2010:

Depart 7AM from K-Mart parking lot. Today we travel through the Shenandoah Valley to Gettysburg, PA. Rest and lunch stop en route arriving at our hotel approximately 4PM. Lodging for the next three nights is at the Quality Inn Gettysburg. Join us at an included Welcome Dinner at the historic Dobbin House Tavern, built in 1776. (D)

#### Day Two - April 16, 2010:

Enjoy our included breakfast at the hotel. This morning we travel to Lancaster County, PA to visit with the Amish for the day. Enjoy a visit to the Bird-In-Hand Farmer's Market and a guided countryside tour with stops at some local Amish shops. Lunch is on your own at the Kitchen Kettle Village. This afternoon we see the spectacular performance of the Sight & Sound Millennium Theatre's new show for 2010, **JOSEPH**, followed by a smorgasbord dinner at the Hershey Farm Restaurant. Then return to our hotel in Gettysburg. (B, D)



#### Day Three - April 17, 2010:

Civil War history is the theme for today. Enjoy your included breakfast at the hotel. This morning we visit the brand new National Park Service Museum and Visitor Center. See the museum's Civil War artifacts, the film, "a New Birth of Freedom" and the fully restored Gettysburg Cyclorama. Lunch is included today at General Pickett's Buffet. This afternoon we will have a licensed battlefield guide join us for a tour visiting the battlefield and the various significant sites of this dramatic event. Dinner is on your own tonight at one the many restaurants located near the hotel. (B, L)

#### Day Four - April 18, 2010:

Breakfast is included at our hotel. This morning we visit the Eisenhower National Historic Site, home and farm of President Dwight D. Eisenhower. Located adjacent to the Gettysburg Battlefield, the farm served the President as a weekend retreat and a meeting place for world leaders. We then depart for home. Meal and rest stops en route, arriving in Burlington approximately 8PM. (B)
