Tour Itinerary:

Day One - September 21, 2010:

Depart 6AM from K-Mart parking lot. Today is our big travel day. We travel to Allen Park, Michigan, just outside of Detroit. Rest and lunch stops en route arriving at our hotel approximately 6PM. Lodging for the next two nights is at the Best Western Greenfield. Join us at an included Welcome Dinner at our hotel. (D)

Day Two - September 22, 2010:

Enjoy our included breakfast buffet at the hotel. This morning we tour the famous Ford Rouge Factory where Ford F-150 trucks are assembled right before



your eyes. Have lunch on your own at their café. Then we visit the Edsel (Henry's son) & Eleanor Ford Estate along the shores of Gross Pointe on Lake St. Clair (connects Lake Huron with Lake Erie). Tour the Walter P. Chrysler Museum featuring three stories of more than 70 antique, custom and concept vehicles and interactive displays and historical exhibits that tell the story of automobile design, technology and innovation, as well as the it's impact on American culture. Dinner this evening is on your own at the hotel. (B)

Day Three - September 23, 2010:

Enjoy our included breakfast buffet at the hotel. Today we work our way north, to Acme, MI for an included lunch and tour at the Music House Museum, a one-of-a-kind collection of rare antique musical instruments and music-making machines, from 1870 through 1930. We arrive in Charlevoix, MI, a charming resort town located on Lake Michigan. Enjoy a driving tour past unique "mushroom houses" designed by architect Earl Young. Dip your toes in Lake Michigan before checking in at the Weathervane Terrace Inn. This evening is free to explore the shops, restaurants and harbor views this resort town offers. (B, L)



Day Four - September 24, 2010:

Breakfast is included at your leisure. This morning we travel through the scenic Tunnel of Trees along Lake Michigan. Over the five mile long Mackinac Bridge we arrive in Sault Ste. Marie, MI for a tour the cargo ship, SS Valley Camp. Built in 1917, the ship is 550 feet in length and now features a variety of displays on shipwrecks, lighthouses, and local history including the unexplained sinking in 1975 of the freighter, the Edmund Fitzgerald. Next a luncheon cruise will take us through the Soo Locks connecting Lake Superior and Lake Huron. At Mackinaw City, MI we meet our afternoon ferry that will take us to the Mackinac Island on Lake Huron for a two night stay at the famous and luxurious Grand Hotel. No vehicles are allowed on Mackinac Island so you and your luggage will be transported by

horse drawn carriage from the ferry terminal to the Grand Hotel. Dinner is included tonight, a fabulous five course meal at the Grand Hotel. After dinner, relax and enjoy the evening entertainment provided by hotel. (B, D)



Day Five - September 25, 2010:

A full day to enjoy Mackinac Island and the Grand Hotel. Breakfast is included at the hotel. This morning enjoy an included horse drawn carriage tour of the island. The afternoon is yours to explore the island or make use of the hotel's amenities. Another fabulous dinner tonight is included at the Grand Hotel. Enjoy the evening entertainment provided by hotel. (B, D)

Day Six - September 26, 2010:

Breakfast is included at the Grand Hotel at your leisure. A late departure this morning so you can enjoy the island. After our ferry to the mainland we board the coach to travel to Frankenmuth, MI. En route we will tour the Cross in the Woods National Shrine, the the worlds largest Wooden and Bronze Crucifix. Be sure to see the Nun Doll Museum, a collection of over 525 dolls. Our hotel tonight is the lovely Bavarian Inn Lodge. A world famous Frankenmuth Bavarian Chicken Dinner with authentic German entertainment is included. After dinner we will drive-thru the nightly Christmas lights at Bronner's Christmas Wonderland. (B, D)



Day Seven - September 27, 2010:

Breakfast is included at the hotel. Enjoy a guided tour of Frankenmuth, then we stop at Bronner's Christmas Wonderland to visit their Silent Night Chapel, a replica of the Oberndorf Chapel in Austria. Time for Christmas ornament shopping at Bronner's before we leave Michigan to head towards home. Our route takes us to Berlin, OH in Holmes County Ohio where the highest concentration of Amish in the United States live. A dinner in an Amish home is included tonight. (B, D)



Day Eight - September 28, 2010:

Breakfast is included at the hotel. Before heading home we will tour the Amish countryside with stops at a couple of local Amish shops. Meal and rest stops en route, arrival in Burlington is approximately 8PM. (B)
